Regular Expressions:

- One of the most fascinating and efficient forms of string manipulation used in modern programming. I initially learned regular expressions as a result of studying Perl and advanced usage of the grep tool on linux systems
- Expert understanding of the principles used by the *regex* engine and the implementation of PCRE in both PHP and JavaScript in addition to Perl
- I work with perl style regular expressions on a day-to-day basis and have written online tutorials on the use of them

Web Accessibility & Standards:

- I firmly believe that content fit for the public via the world wide web should be fit for everybody and I take great pride in ensuring my work is accessible to as many people of possible regardless of any impairments or the specific software/hardware used to access it
- I have taken much time in learning the guidelines laid out by the W3C in order to promote such accessibility and push towards ensuring the developers of the web browsers follow these standards

Object-Oriented Programming:

- Quite possibly the most organised and effective way to build applications in languages which support it, leading to easy maintenance and easy to read, logically laid out source code
- I find the subject area of design patterns in OOP extremely interesting and almost invaluable to learn since they provide a great asset to any developer
- Using OOP in application design presents developers with an open gateway to using agile development techniques, in particular, Test Driven Development

GNU/Linux Experience

- I use Ubuntu Linux on the desktop as my primary operating system. I'm extremely familiar with the underlying linux system through working with both Gentoo Linux and ArchLinux (aka AL) systems and as a result of which can handle and manipulate linux systems very effectively
 - All development work done in my current job has been produced and hosted on the ArchLinux system
 - I'm extremely familiar with networking capabilities on GNU/Linux systems
 - I have maintained and administered a VDS server running Gentoo Linux for the last 18 months, providing DNS, HTTP, FTP and IMAP4/POP3 E-mail to multiple domains, with multiple users. As a result of which I have learned an extreme amount about linux security and public server management
 - Worked with a small team of Linux server administrators to build a cluster of eight linux (AL) servers running MySQL with the NDB engine

Author of Swift Mailer:

- Swift Mailer is a fully pluggable PHP Mailing library. It can handle (technically) any connection given to it that follows the API
- I wrote this since I have a strong understanding of MTAs and SMTP servers as a result of running one. After seeing a lot of requests for easy ways to handle mail attachments, Bcc recipients and batch emailing I decided to write Swift. It was never intended to reach the scale it has reached but demand has kept this library in development
- Swift's Plugin System is a concept in itself, and has stirred a bit of interest among some well known PHP developers

DevNetwork Forum Administrator:

- I dedicate a lot of my spare time to my role on the hugely popular DevNetwork PHP Forums
- Being an administrator involves the maintenance of the bulletin board as well as making decisions over changes on the board
- I get a lot of satisfaction from volunteering to be a part of a community of like-minded individuals who are all either working in, or learning PHP
